CLOTH LINE KIT

EQUIPMENT:

Line Kit; Hammer; Nails and stripe; Water bucket; Brushing roller (eg. Paint brush roller); Warm water & Normal freezing tools

Before marking, the bottom ice must be heavy and even. Suitable temperature is -2 to -20 degrees Celsius (29 to -5F).

- 1. **CENTRE LINE:** (Band width 300mm 12")
 - a. Drive a nail into both sides of the rink 6" from the median line of the rink. Stretch a string between the nails.
 - b. Place the line on the ice with the help of string and prefasten at intervals with drops of water. In normal circumstances, utilize brush roller to moisten with warm water, allowing the line to absorb the water so that it freezes onto the ice.
 - c. Should this be an exterior application, it is necessary in windy weather to unwind the line as it is fastened to the ice surface.
 - d. Remove string and nails.
- 2. **BLUE LINES:** (Band width 300mm 12")
 - a. Utilize the same method as with Centre Line.
- 3. **GOAL LINES:** (Band width 50mm red -2")
 - a. Utilize the same method as with Centre Line.
- 4. FACE-OFF CIRCLES: (Band width 50mm blue 2") A-FACE-OFF POINT (300mm blue 12")
 - a. Drive a nail into the centre of the A-Face-Off Circle and draw with string and another nail a circular arc, radius 4.5m (15').
- 5. CIRCULAR ARCS OF REFEREE ARENA, P-FACE-OFF POINT AND 50MM (2") LONG STRAIGHT LINES OF P-POINT AREAS: (band width 50mm red 2")
- 6. GOALKEEPER AREA CIRCLES (50mm red -2")
- 7. **P-FACE-OFF POINTS T-LINES** (50mm red -2")
- 8. **OTHER FACE-OFF POINTS, NEUTRAL AREA, P-POINTS** (600mm red-white 24")
- 9. Freeze an ice layer of 5 to 10mm (.197" to .394") over the markings.

Kit contains material for 2 applications: 2 rolls of 12" x 102' Red, 4 rolls of 12" x 102' Blue, 14 rolls of 2" x 102' Red, 2 rolls of 2" x 102' Blue, 16 of 24" Red Face-off Dots, 2 of 12" Blue Face-off Dots and 1 Instruction sheet.
